Art Competition



This week is **Walk to School Week**. Walking to school helps us stay active and notice the world around us. Let's create a picture from the beautiful things we discover!

You will need:

- An envelope
- An A4 sheet of card
- White School Glue
- A paint brush
- Optional - scissors

1.



Walk to school and use your senses: what can you see, hear and smell? Enjoy nature but stay aware of your surroundings and keep safe.

2.



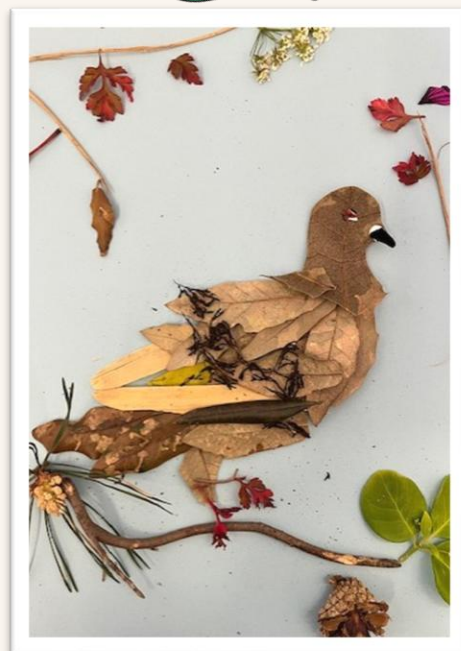
Use an envelope to collect natural items you find on the ground (e.g. leaves, petals, small sticks).

Don't pick flowers or harm living things.

After the walk, lay out your items and notice the different shapes and colours.

On an A4 piece of card, arrange your items to create a picture of anything you like. It could be something you saw or felt on the walk. Try layering your items and cutting into them with scissors.

5.

Use glue to stick everything down. Use tape for any tricky parts.

6.

Label your work with the walk date and your name.
