Writing

This half term in writing we are going to be building up to write a recount from the text 'Neon's secret universe', where the children will practise summarising chapters and adding language devices to their writing such as prepositions, adverbials and apostrophes. The second text we will look at is 'Rapunzel' where we will use direct speech to create an alternative fairytale.

Reading

We will be covering Year 4 reading objectives through our texts, concentrating on the skills of visualising and clarifying. We will look closely at the words authors have chosen to inspire and engage the reader which help us to imagine the world they have created, and how the presentation of a text helps us to understand its meaning.

Maths

This half term we will continue to solidify our column addition and subtraction as well as investigate patterns within times tables to help us to learn our multiplication and division facts. We will also look at analysing discrete and continuous data.

We will continue to work through the 3 times tables and move onto the 4 times tables booklet in our number sense sessions.

Science

This term we will be studying three different states of matter: solid, liquid and gas. We will be investigating how these change, including an in-depth look at the water cycle and the processes of condensation and evaporation.

DT

Throughout this half term, we will be looking at the craft technique of sewing, stitching a stocking which they will design themselves. We will explore different sewing and decorating techniques as well as evaluate our final product.

Wider curriculum

Music: We will be continuing to learn the ukeleles as well as explore musical journeys.

RE: In RE this half term, we will be learning about the Old and New Testaments and look into Noah's Ark.

Geography

We will learn about human and physical geographical features in Dorset and across other counties. We will look at how these features affect the environment and tourism and use our map skills to locate each location.

PE

PE lessons will be every WEDNESDAY and THURSDAY. We will be learning dance on Wednesdays and Thursdays are still swimming.

Computing: In Computing, we will be learning what the internet is and how we keep connected through different networks.
