Writing

Our text this half term is 'The Wild Robot' by Peter Brown, which follows Roz, a newly manufactured robot who becomes a castaway on an island with no human inhabitants. We will slowly work through the unit to build up to writing our own narrative, including a setting description. The outcome for this text will be a narrative based on the text, to entertain Bearwood teachers.

Reading

We will be covering Year 4 reading objectives through our texts, concentrating on the skills of visualising and clarifying. We will look closely at the words authors have chosen to inspire and engage the reader which help us to imagine the world they have created, and how the presentation of a text helps us to understand its meaning.

Maths

In Maths, Willow 2 will start Summer 2 finishing our learning on decimals, and then we will move onto some further practice on our fractions learning.

History

This half term in Geography, Willow 2 will be learning about the human and physical features of Europe. We will be using our map skills to place countries and capital cities on a blank map and look for reasons as to why cities have built up in certain places.

DT

In evaluate. our DT unit, Willow 2 will be learning about the famous inventor, Alexander Graham Bell who invented the telephone. We will design our own telephones and use different materials to see which are most effective in transporting sound using the method of designing.
