Behaviour Policy

At Bearwood Primary and Nursery School we believe that at the heart of effective teaching and learning is the quality of the relationship between the pupils and their teacher based on mutual respect. As a school we adopt a Trauma Informed approach when supporting pupil behaviour.

PE Kit Reminder

Reception Class Weights & Measures

Each year in England, school children in Reception and Year 6 have their height and weight checked at school as part of the National Child Measurement Programme. Height and weight measurements are used to calculate weight status. Oak 2 will be having their measurements taken next month. A letter will be coming out to parents separately today with full details. If you do not want your child to take part you must email the school office to remove your consent.
