

Your child has been creating his/her own design for a Christmas Card and it will be sent home this afternoon, should you prefer to help your child complete an alternative design please feel free to do so following the guidelines below.

DEADLINE Monday 19th October.



Cauliflower Cards

Guidelines for completing your artwork:

- Artwork must be completed on A4 or A5 paper or card. This can be either landscape or portrait.
- Attach the artwork to your order form with a glue stick (please don't use staples, paperclips or sellotape).
- Circle the tree on the order form to show the orientation of your design.
- Keep important details such as text and border designs at least 1cm away from the edge of the design.
- Keep designs unfolded and damage free as creases and marks will show on the final print.

Good results:

- ✓ To complete the design you can use a wide range of materials including collage.
- ✓ Bold and bright designs that fill the paper produce the best effect.

Do not use:

- Photos printed on glossy paper.
- Transparent film covering your artwork
- Light pencil.

Artwork, completed order form and payments (preferably ParentMail) must be returned to school on or before Monday 19th October.
