The programme is designed to raise environmental awareness amongst young people and in England it is run by environmental charity Keep Britain Tidy. The Eco-Schools programme empowers pupils, raises environmental awareness, improves the school environment and can also lead to financial saving. Being an active member of the programme will be something your child will remember for the rest of their life.

The programme focuses on ten important environmental topics:

- 1. Biodiversity
- 2. Energy
- 3. Global Citizenship
- 4. Healthy Living
- 5. Litter
- 6. Marine
- 7. School Grounds
- 8. Transport
- 9. Waste
- 10. Water

Every school taking part in the Eco-Schools around the world programme follow the same simple Seven Step framework. This usually takes schools between one and two academic years to complete. After achieving our first Green Flag, our school can continue in the programme and achieve multiple Green Flags whilst continuing to work on and promote environmental issues. One of the most exciting things about the programme is that the process is designed to engage the whole school and its wider community.

During the initial steps of this journey, one thing that pupil voice has raised is that there is a high need to develop our outdoor school grounds. Together, with our Friends of Birdsedge group, this is something we are keen to develop, as quickly as we can. This will support our work towards this Green Flag but also and most importantly, will improve the opportunities and experiences for all our children.
