Dear Families

This month has been a really productive one for myself and for school and it feels brilliant to feel like we are moving ahead with plans that we know will help to raise this wonderful little school to the place it deserves to be. There are two things I'm really excited to share with you that are coming soon for school. Please do share these over the coming weeks with other families who might be interested – positive word of mouth from parents and carers is always our most powerful tool. Firstly, on **Wednesday 9th June** at **9:30am** our weekly 'Tree Tots' session begins. A group for parents and children aged 2-4. Secondly, I am currently finalising plans for a Summer Holiday Club for children aged 5 – 10 here at school. We are hopeful that we can run a **TWO** week Club from **Monday 2**nd **Aug** – **Friday 13**th **Aug**. Thank you for all your quick responses to my questions about this, this week. I'm delighted to be able to run this and should it be a success would love this to be the start of something for school regularly in school holidays. One final thing I would like to share is that we have been working hard on a brand new curriculum design for school launching in September, designed around a progressive model making sure children learn more and remember more as they move through school. Enhanced with trips and experiences for EVERY topic and a rich reading list that drives our reading culture further forward. All of this whilst also developing teachers who become specialists in their focus subjects to enhance and bring even more consistency to the teaching of the wider curriculum. Covid 19 Updates
