Subject Spotlight Handwriting

We have been doing lots of thinking about handwriting and spelling recently and how we can better support children to develop and embed these important skills. Coming home this week with every child is a handwriting pack that we ask stays in book bags so it can be used regularly at home and school for handwriting practice. In here is a guide to early transcription and handwriting skills for parents and carers to read and some resources and tools to support children to develop, practice and maintain quality fine motor skills and handwriting. These can also be found in our Curriculum – Reading, Writing and Phonics Page on the school website:

English – Reading, Writing & Phonics | Birdsedge First School One of the biggest things parents can support with when it comes to homework is the regular practice of basic skills – practicing spellings, number fluency such as times tables, regular reading and handwriting. We hope this pack will give a consistent way of practicing handwriting and early transcription skills that can be done in short manageable sessions as and when you can – we do ask that these are kept together and in book bags so children can use them in dedication transcription sessions in school too daily. As always – if you have any questions or need any support please do not hesitate to reach out to teachers.
