## Subject Spotlight – Religious Education

Religious Education is taught through a weekly lesson in classes, following our Curriculum Plan designed using the Kirklees Scheme of Study. We also have regular RE focused assemblies each week to enhance learning in classrooms. Like with other subjects, we will be dedicating some enrichment time during our subject spotlight month to RE. We have chosen to do this next week to link with World Religion Day on Sunday.

During the week each class will be focussing on a Key Religion and will be exploring it through a variety of medias. The focus on the deep understanding of concepts (like forgiveness, empathy) will give children the opportunity within subjects, not just surface-level knowledge.

As part of World Religion Day we will be connecting RE to the Real World: Linking lessons to local, national, and global contexts, preparing children for a diverse society. We are hoping to speak to people of faith, try foods from different cultures, research arts and develop skills that apply across subjects and life.
