Class Structures September 2025

With first choice offers now being made, we can plan more firmly for class structures in September. I'm delighted to share with you that we will continue with three classes in September 2025 and be returning to the traditional structure of two year groups per class as below:

Class 1: Reception and Year 1

Class 2: Year 2 and Year 3

Class 3 Year 4 and Year 5

We will also continue to offer a fourth class, full time, offering more personalised and specialist support and provision for those children with special educational needs or disabilities.

Our final week before the summer holidays will be transition week in school where all children will be supported to get used to any new class groupings or rooms – although most children will remain with the same peers and in the same spaces they are in now We also have some transition plans for this same week that have been shared with new families yesterday for those children who will be new to school in September.

Staffing Update

Another positive piece of news to share with you today, is that in September we will be having a new full time teaching member of staff joining our team. Miss Laycock, who has been working in Class 3 over the year as part of her studies will be joining us as a teacher, mainly in Class 1 from September 2025. Of course, Miss Hutton remains with us remains the adding capacity around Miss Hutton's growing role as Assistant Headteacher and SENDCo. Miss Laycock has kindly written you all a letter of introduction attached to the newsletter.

As yet, I have no further updates with regards to when Mr Newing will be returning to work, however, Miss Ahmedjee remains with us and in Class 3 throughout the Summer Term in the meantime ⁽²⁾
