Dear Parents/Carers,

Here at Bishop Aldhelm's we are so fortunate to be so close to our local heath which enables the children to learn about the plants and animals which inhabit the local area of the school, an exciting and important part of their understanding of the world development.

We have organised for the children to visit the heath on **Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June**. We will be met by 3 heath rangers from the Urban Heath Partnership who will lead the classes in exploring the heath and carrying out a variety of fun learning activities. They will be encouraging the children to observe the heath landscape in Summer. We will then compare what we see to our observations on the heath walk in Autumn.

We will walk to the heath from the back gate of the field and down the gravel path. The children will be accompanied by adults from the school and the heath partnership staff.

Please can you make sure your child is wearing a long sleeve top and long trousers for this outing. They can wear their PE kit if you wish or their own clothes on this day. The children can change into their wellies when they arrive at school. Please can they have sun cream applied before they come to school and bring a sun hat if the weather is sunny.

The children always really enjoy the heath walks from school and learn so much about nature. We are really looking forward to taking them! We hope this letter explains the activity fully but if you have any queries regarding the outing please talk to your child's class teacher.
