Warm Weather Guidance

As we move into the next half term, we are expecting periods of warmer weather. We would like to take this opportunity to ensure that all children remain safe, comfortable, and ready to learn during the hotter days.

To help support this, we kindly ask that you:

- Apply sun cream before school: Please ensure your child has sunscreen applied before arriving at school each morning. Staff are not always able to reapply lotion during the day, so a good initial application is important.
- Provide a sun hat: A hat will help protect your child from the sun during outdoor activities, including playtimes and PE sessions.
- Dress in summer uniform: Where applicable, children are encouraged to wear the school's summer uniform to stay cool.
- Send in a named water bottle: It is important that children stay well hydrated throughout the day. Please ensure they bring a clearly labelled water bottle to school every day.

We will continue to take sensible precautions in school, such as encouraging regular water breaks and making use of shaded areas.
