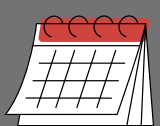

Supporting Our Pupils During the Current Hot Weather

We acknowledge the recent spell of hot weather and to reassure you that the school is taking appropriate steps to ensure the safety, comfort, and wellbeing of all pupils during these warmer conditions.

Throughout the school day, we are actively monitoring temperatures and making sensible adjustments where needed. This includes encouraging regular water breaks, ensuring pupils have access to shaded areas during outdoor activities, reducing prolonged exposure to direct sunlight, and modifying physical activity where appropriate. Staff are also reminding children about the importance of staying hydrated and recognising the signs of overheating. You can also help...

- **Provide a water bottle:** Please ensure your child brings a clearly labelled water bottle to school each day. We encourage frequent drinking to stay hydrated.
- **Apply sun protection:** Apply a high-factor to your child before school. If appropriate, you may also send sunscreen with them (clearly labelled) for reapplication.
- **Suitable clothing:** Light, loose-fitting clothing is recommended. Where uniform policies allow, please ensure your child is dressed as comfortably as possible.
- **Hats and shade:** A wide-brimmed hat or cap is strongly encouraged to protect your child during outdoor time.
- **Adequate rest:** Warm weather can be tiring. Ensuring your child gets a good night's sleep will help them stay alert and comfortable during the school day.
- **Healthy lunches and snacks:** Where possible, include fresh fruits or lighter options that are refreshing and easy to eat in warmer conditions.

Additional Considerations

If your child has any medical conditions that may be affected by the heat, please ensure the school is fully informed and that any necessary medication is provided.
