Important: Sun Safety Measures for Children

As the weather improves and we enjoy more sunny days, it's important to ensure our children are protected from the sun's harmful rays. We kindly ask for your cooperation with the following sun safety measures:

Sun Hats

Please ensure your child brings a sun hat to school every day. A wide-brimmed hat is ideal as it provides better protection for the face, neck, and ears.

Sun Cream

We recommend applying sunscreen to your child in the morning before they come to school. A broad-spectrum sunscreen with an SPF of at least 30 is advisable.

Hydration

Encourage your child to drink plenty of water throughout the day to stay hydrated.
