This will allow pupils to enjoy a 'camping-style' experience in a safe, familiar environment while still benefiting from the excitement of spending a night away from home with their friends.

We are currently working to complete a timetable of activities for the visit, and further details will be shared with you shortly.

- Children will arrive at school on the Friday morning as usual, bringing their overnight bags and sleeping equipment.
- Throughout the day, pupils will take part in a range of planned activities including South Coast Adventures who will bring their climbing wall, cave and archery equipment.
- Children will enjoy their packed lunch and a cooked tea, supper and breakfast provided by school.
- Evening activities will take place on site, after which pupils will sleep inside the school building under full staff supervision.
- The following morning, children will have breakfast before being collected.
