Year 4 – Lulworth Cove and Durdle Door visit

I am happy to tell you that we are planning a day trip to Lulworth Cove and Durdle Door on **Friday 9th October 2026**. The visit links to our Geography topic of Coasts and will be a field study of the coast line in our local areas. Whilst there, the children will have a chance to study Durdle Door before walking along the coastal path to Lulworth Cove to both study it and enjoy some time on the beach.

DESTINATION	Durdle Door and Lulworth Cove
DATE OF VISIT	Friday 9th October 2026
DEPARTURE TIME	9.15am (By coach)
RETURN TIME	3:15pm (By coach)
DRESS	PE kit with suitable trainers for walking and a waterproof coat
PUPILS WILL NEED	A bag, packed lunch, waterproof coat, sun hat and sun cream, water bottle
TRAVEL	We will be travelling by coach to and from Durdle Door and Lulworth Cove
ACTIVITIES	Studying the coastline and rock formations, walking along the coastal path and spending time on the beach.

Lunch: All children are required to bring a packed lunch.

NB. If your child is entitled to receive free school meals a packed lunch will be provided. If you have ordered a hot free school meal with Chartwells, this will be converted to a packed lunch for the day of the trip.

If you have paid for a hot meal with Chartwells for the day of the trip, it will be converted to a packed lunch unless you cancel it directly with Chartwells (they require that you 'make on-line alterations prior to the cut-off point for the week in question (i.e. minimum 14 days for the entire week in question).
