

Chronology

Children will know who is in their immediate family.

Children will know that the past is something that has already happened and that the future is something that hasn't happened yet.

Children will know that they were once a baby and have some understanding of how they will grow

Children will be aware of some celebrations like birthdays and Christmas and how these are celebrated. They will be aware of some significant events.

Historical enquiry

Children will be able to use evidence to help with their understanding of the past, such as photos and objects.

Children will look at stories with a historical perspective and discuss how they can teach us about the past.

Children will begin to talk about the lives of people around them and their roles in society. They will share stories that are set in the past and will consider how the setting and characters differ from today.

Children will look at images of familiar situations in the past and consider how these are different now.

Children will use small world and imaginative play to explore life in the past.

Monarchy

Children will have an awareness of the Royal family. They will know that there have been kings and queens in the past and will be in the future. They will experience resources linked to the monarchy such as kings and queens dressing up and knights and castles small world.

Children will have an awareness of key events such as Remembrance Day. They will experience resources linked to invasions such as kings and queens dressing up and knights and castles small world.
