Warwick Year 12 Sutton Trust Summer Schools

Warwick is one of 12 UK universities that are part of the Sutton Trust UK Summer Schools programme. Our summer school will take place from Monday 2nd August to Friday 6th August 2021.

We are hoping to deliver the summer school face to face, at the University of Warwick campus. However keeping students and staff safe is of paramount importance to us so we are keeping a close eye on government guidance and the developing situation. If we are unable to deliver the programmes face to face, we will have a blended or digital programme of support through our new platform Sutton Trust Online.

It is a fantastic opportunity for your eligible Year 12 students to gain an insight into studying their chosen subject and life at the University. They will be able to interact with Student Ambassadors who are current students at the University, attend academic sessions, try out fun activities and live away from home for four nights and five days in our halls of residence.

Who is it for?

To be eligible you have to:

- Be attending, and have always attended, a state-funded school or college (non-fee paying) in the UK.
- Be in Year 12

We are also looking for applicants who meet the below criteria. The more of these criteria you meet, the more likely you are to secure a place.

- Have been eligible for free schools meals
- Would be in the first generation of their family to attend university
- Attend a school or college with a below-average A-level or Higher point score and/or a low rate of progression to higher education
- Live in a neighbourhood with a low rate of progression to higher education and/or a high level of socio-economic deprivation .
- Have achieved at least five A or 7 grades at GCSE, or five A or B passes at National 5, and where applicable, taken subjects relevant to the course applied for.






