



Arrival at School

Measures put in place by school

- There will be a staggered start to the school day with year 7 and 8 arriving at 8:40am, year 9 at 9:00am, year 10 and 11 at 8:50am and year 12 and 13 at 8:40am.
- Where possible, we ask that students arrive to school close to their designated start time however, school will be open from 7am as usual to all students.
- We are fully supportive of sibling groups arriving together.
- Sixth form will arrive to school through the main reception. Students should sign in with their lanyards. They should not use the touchscreen facilities.
- Yr7-11 students will arrive to school through the main student entrance at the front of school.
- Students should not be arriving to school in large groups and senior staff will be on duty to support with this.

- If a student arrives late to school they should sign in at the main reception in the usual way.
