BANKSY LEFT A NOTE FOR THE HOSPITAL WORKERS, WHICH READ: "THANKS FOR ALL YOU'RE DOING. I HOPE THIS BRIGHTENS THE PLACE UP A BIT, EVEN IF IT'S ONLY BLACK AND WHITE."
