Appeals Process

Updated 4th May 2021

Teacher Assessed Grades for 2021 will be published in August.

- 10th August for A-level and Level 3 vocational qualifications.
- 12th August for GCSE and Level 2 vocational qualifications.

After results are published students have the right to appeal the Teacher Assessed Grade they have been awarded.

An appeal can result in a grade **going down** as well as remaining the same or going up.

Students will have to provide written consent for an appeal.

These are the current details of the process:

Step 1

- The student appeals to the centre to confirm that there has not been an administrative error and that internal processes have been followed.

Step 2

- The school appeals to the relevant exam board on the student's behalf. They will examine the evidence used by the centre to reach the Teacher Assessed Grade.
