HPV Vaccination

School Name: 103560 - Bishop Challoner Catholic College

School-aged children are offered the human papillomavirus vaccination (HPV) via the national school aged immunisation programme. This is now a single dose only as this has been found to be as effective.

The School Aged Immunisation Service (SAIS) offers this vaccine in school in year 8, or in year 9 if missed in year 8.

HPV vaccine helps protect against HPV related cancers later in life, such as:

- cervical cancer (young girls)
- some mouth and throat cancers
- some cancers of the anus and genital areas.

The HPV vaccine does not contain gelatine.
