Measures put in place by school

- The school will operate a revised one-way system from September. The new system will maximise the use of outside routes when circulating. The revised system will be shared with students upon return to school. All students must follow the one-way system at all times.
- Due to the complex and compact nature of our school site we will require students to circulate between lessons. This will be a controlled movement with year 7 and 8 moving first and older year groups after. We expect older students to show maturity and adhere to social distancing as they circulate. All staff will be on duty to support social distancing between lessons.
- Signage and floor markings will be positioned around the school to support with circulation and social distancing.
- School bells will be used to indicate lesson transitions but will not be used for staggered breaks, arrival or departure.
