Today's Gospel

Six days before the Passover, Jesus went to Bethany, where Lazarus was, whom he had raised from the dead. They gave a dinner for him there; Martha waited on them and Lazarus was among those at table. Mary brought in a pound of very costly ointment, pure nard, and with it anointed the feet of Jesus, wiping them with her hair; the house was full of the scent of the ointment. Then Judas Iscariot — one of his disciples, the man who was to betray him — said, 'Why wasn't this ointment sold for three hundred denarii, and the money given to the poor?' He said this, not because he cared about the poor, but because he was a thief; he was in charge of the common fund and used to help himself to the contributions. So Jesus said, 'Leave her alone; she had to keep this scent for the day of my burial. You have the poor with you always, you will not always have me.'

Meanwhile a large number of Jews heard that he was there and came not only on account of Jesus but also to see Lazarus whom he had raised from the dead. Then the chief priests decided to kill Lazarus as well, since it was on his account that many of the Jews were leaving them and believing in Jesus.

John 12:1-11

In Todays Gospel Reading, we hear about a few days before Jesus was crucified. Today's Gospel reading tells the story of Mary anointing the feet of Jesus with oil just days before the Passion. In this passage, we see Jesus with the closest people to him. Among the people closest to Jesus was Lazarus who was given the gift of life and now enjoying Jesus' pure love and company

Within this piece of scripture, Mary anoints Jesus' feet with expensive oil and then dries his feet with her hair. Mary recognizes that Jesus is the person that she wants to give her all to and impress and that now is the time to do it. When Jesus is before her, she devotes herself to just be present in this time with the Lord.

As we journey closer and closer to Calvary with Jesus this week, may we all listen prayerfully to what the Lord may be calling us to do and answer him with positivity.

As we journey to Calvary this week, we pray for open hearts and an openness to your word. We thank you for the sacrifice you made for us. Let us walk with you in this journey and ever be present to your love, strength and generosity for all of your creation.
