


How to Pray the Rosary:

Start with the Sign of the Cross Say the Apostles Creed Then follow with One Our Father, Three Hail Mary's and A Glory Be

State the Mystery
Then follow with One Our Father
Then pray Ten Hail Marys whilst
reflecting on the mystery
Follow with One Glory Be
and the Oh My Jesus
Repeat for all 5 decades of the Rosary

After the 5th Decade, finish this prayer with a Hail Holy Queen, Final Prayer and the Sign of the Cross

- The Resurrection (Luke 24:1-12)
- The Ascension (Luke 24:50-51)
- The Descent of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1-4)
- The Assumption of Mary into Heaven (Rev. 12)

- The Coronation of Mary (Rev. 12:1).
