Gospel:

God sent his Son into the world so that through him the world might be saved

Jesus said to Nicodemus:

'God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son,

so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost

but may have eternal life.

For God sent his Son into the world

not to condemn the world,

but so that through him the world might be saved.

No one who believes in him will be condemned;

but whoever refuses to believe is condemned already,

because he has refused to believe in the name of God's only Son.

On these grounds is sentence pronounced:

that though the light has come into the world

men have shown they prefer darkness to the light

because their deeds were evil.

And indeed, everybody who does wrong

hates the light and avoids it,

for fear his actions should be exposed;

but the man who lives by the truth comes out into the light,

so that it may be plainly seen that what he does is done in God.'

In todays gospel we hear that Jesus was sent to the earth to help and be the ultimate sacrifice for all our sins. We hear about light and the Lord is often connoted as a light as he has created us all for something significant. We all have a purpose. St John Henry Newman says we are a link in a chain and we have our mission received from God.
