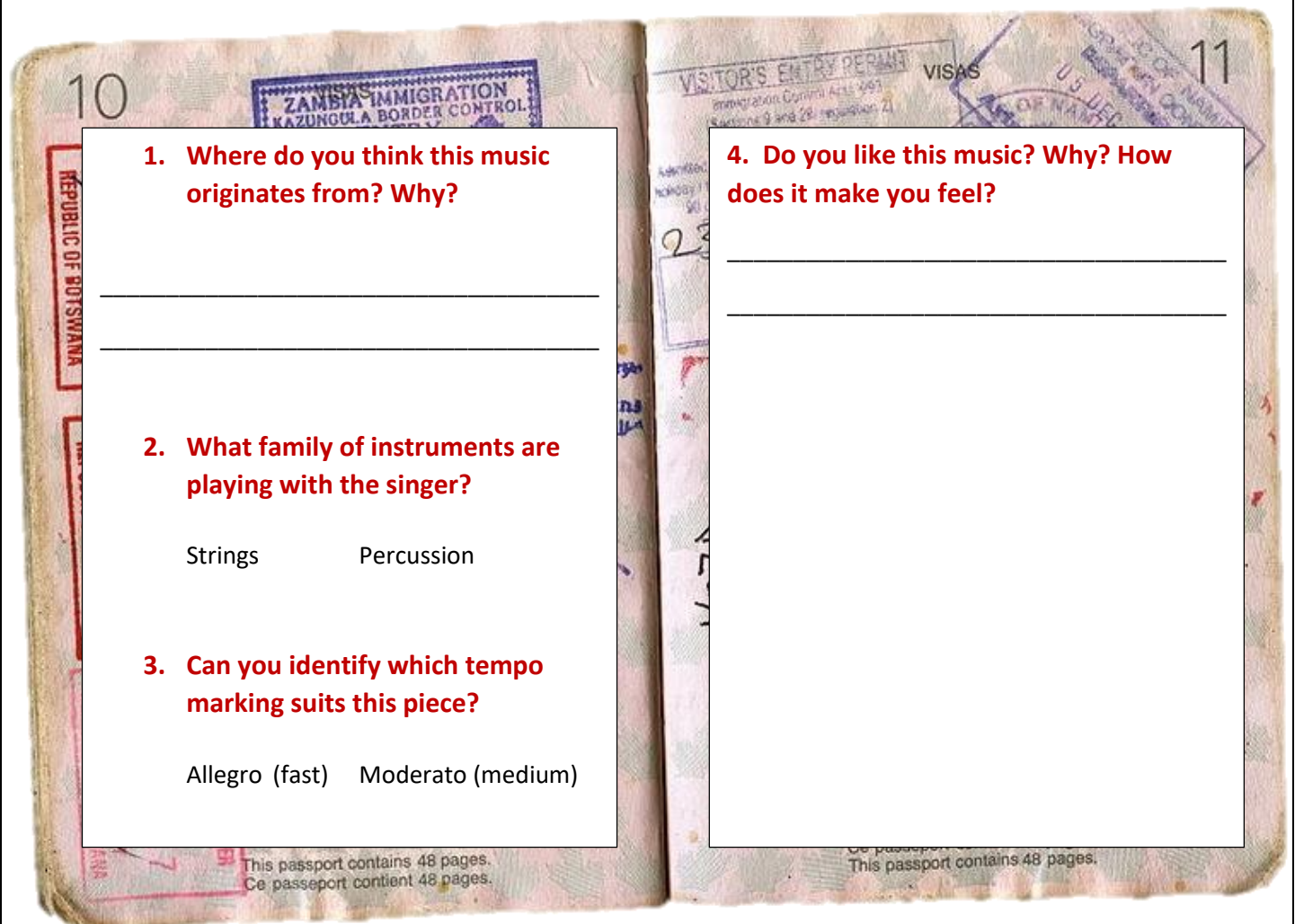

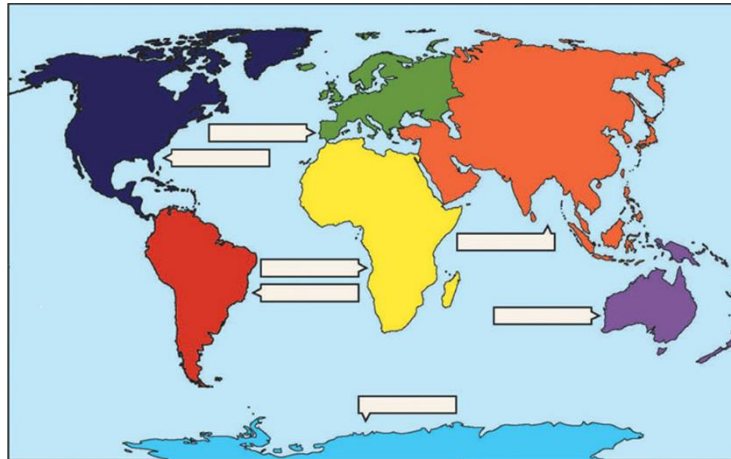

The **D**_____ **D**_____ (pronounced 'jem-bay') is a **s**_____ covered hand drum shaped like a large goblet. It is made of a single **t**_____ trunk (said to contain the soul of the tree) which is shaped and **h**_____ out. The **d**_____ is usually made out of **g**_____ and rope is used to tighten the skin to tune the drum to the appropriate **p**_____. The Djembe can make three different tones – the **b**_____, the **t**_____ and the **s**_____ and is played using the **h**_____.
