It has been a joy to welcome our students back to school this week and I thank our parents/carers and of course our students for their support with the staggered return and the COVID testing that we were required to undertake. We continue to follow the latest Government guidance for schools as the situation evolves. As part of this, we have installed 40 CO2 monitors across the school site so that we can ensure rooms are well ventilated. I thank all our parents and carers for continuing to encourage their children to wear face coverings when in school and for ensuring they complete their lateral flow tests regularly. Linked to this we would ask our school community to continue to be vigilant to the signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and take the necessary actions if required; we shared a letter earlier this week with parents and carers outlining links to the latest guidance with regard to COVID isolation.

We continue to hold in our thoughts and prayers all who have been severely affected by this pandemic.
