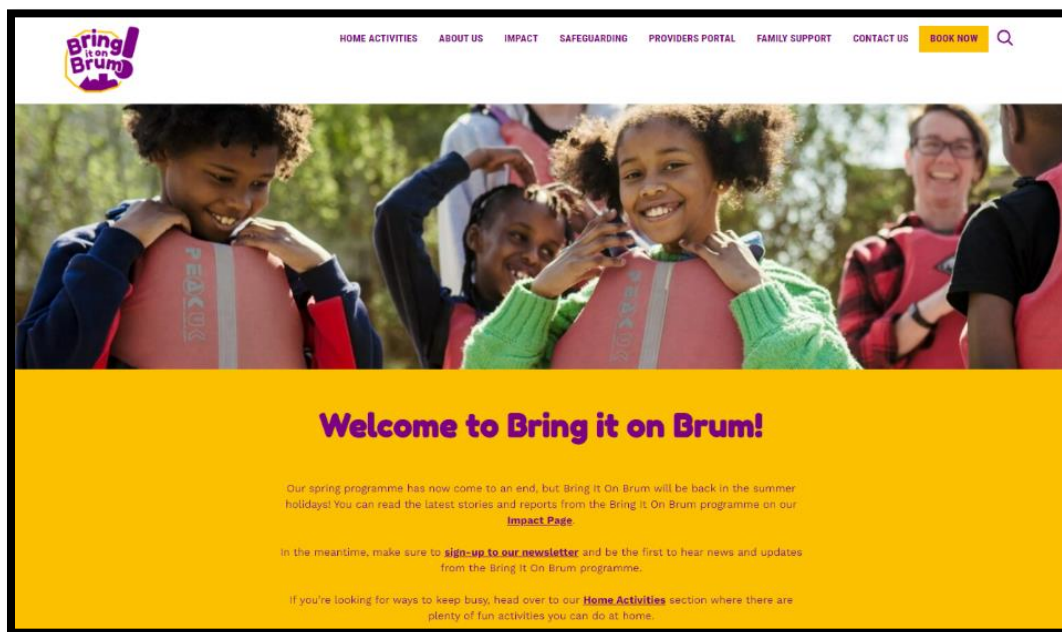
Bring it on Brum! holiday clubs are designed for children who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals. Schools will issue a Bring it on Brum! code to each eligible child.

Families will be asked to confirm this code when they register for any of the listed activities. They need to contact their children school if they have not received the code.



The booking for the summer holiday clubs started the 2nd of July 2024, and families need to undertake the activity via the website. You need to contact the company directly with any enquires.

There are additional free childcare and play related resources on the website which parents can use to entertain their children during the summer holiday period.


WHAT IS BRING IT ON BRUM?

IMPORTANT: You will need a 'BIOB' code from your child's school to book. If you haven't received your code, please contact your school.

STEP 1

1. Go to www.bringitonbrum.co.uk and click **BOOK NOW**
2. Enter your criteria E.g. Location, participant age, date and click **SEARCH**
To view the session details click **MORE INFORMATION**
3. Once you've found a holiday club you like, click **BOOK NOW** and choose a date and time that works for you
4. Enter your child's details – you can add more than one child
You may need to add 'Supplementary Information'.
Please write 'None' in any fields that do not apply.

FREE WEST MIDLANDS TRAVEL **FOR AGES 16+**

StreetGames and **Bring it on Brum!** have been working with **Transport for West Midlands** (TfWM) to promote the recently launched West Midlands Bus Scheme to local families.

This scheme is offering 4 weeks of free bus travel over the summer holiday for parents, carers and older young people aged 16+ years.



Those eligible for the Bus Scheme will be supported with free bus travel via Swift technology and the nBus multi-operator bus ticketing scheme.

The offer will get you a free 4-Week Regional nBus ticket, which allows travel on any bus in the West Midlands bus network.

To claim the offer, an application need to be completed by midnight on Wednesday 17th July 2024.



You will then receive an email with a voucher code and instructions on how to redeem the voucher code and the bus ticket.

Anyone who use the free ticket, you will also be provided a follow-on 25% discount for another 4-Week Regional nBus ticket and then a third 4-week ticket, again at a 25% discount.

Details on this follow-up offer will be emailed to you once you have redeemed your original free nBus ticket.

This offer is thanks to TfWM, who are working with the Department for Transport, local authorities and local bus operators to get the region moving.

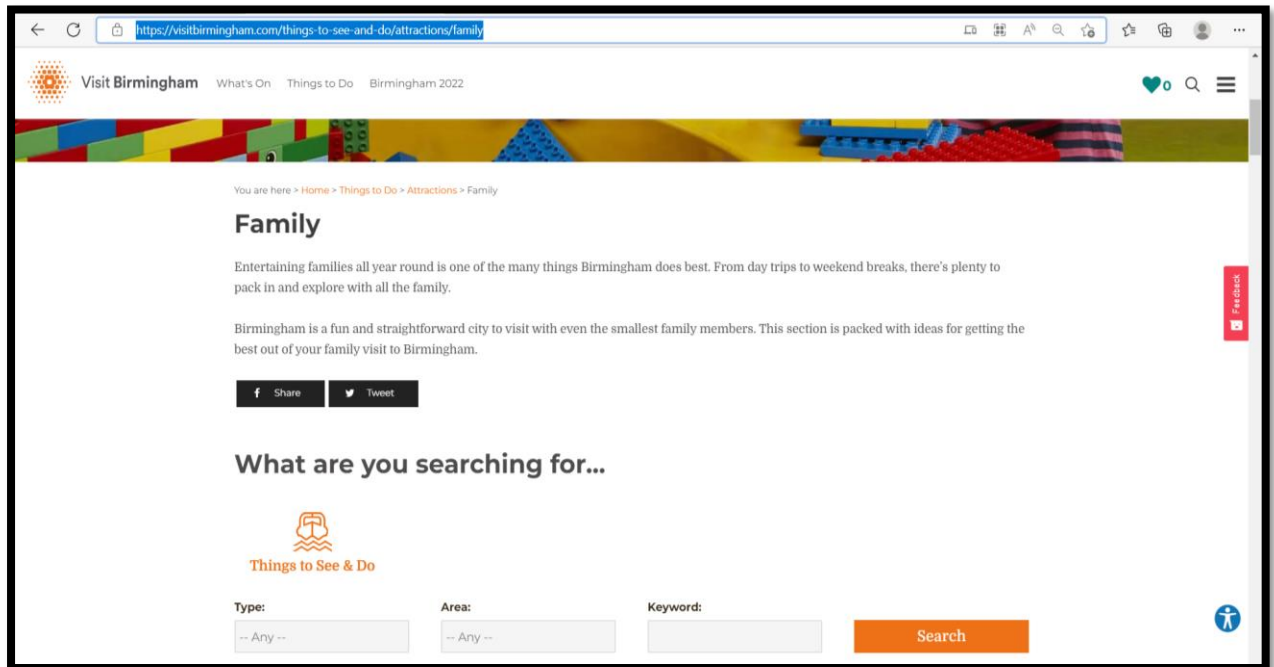

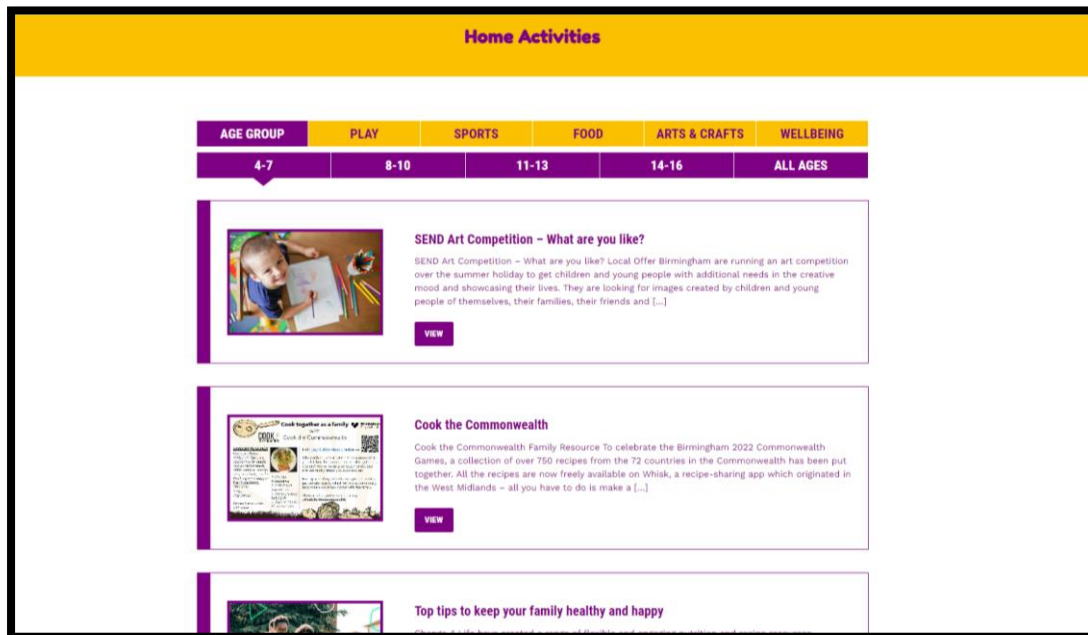

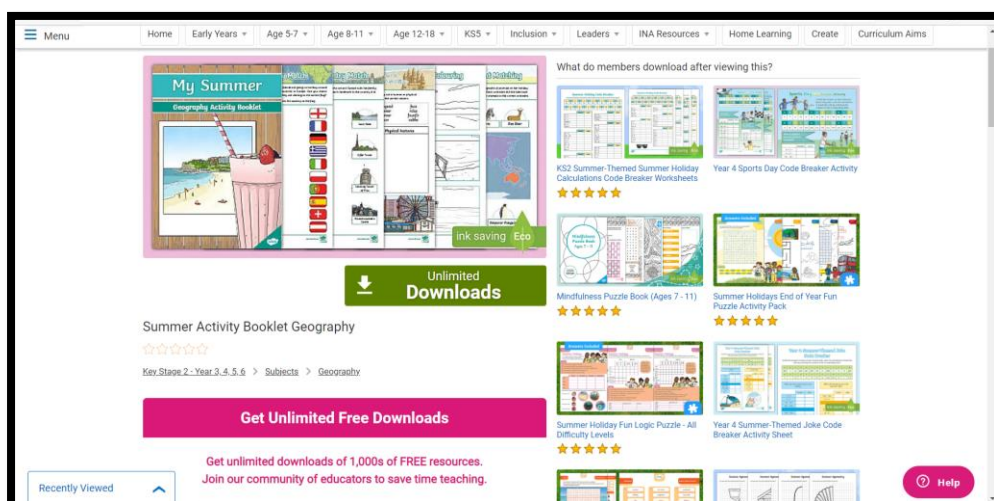
