

<u>Gresham College</u> offer access to a huge variety of free online lectures.









Insight into University Residential W



Insight into University Residential Experience (previously known as Headstart) are summer schools run over 4 or 5 days where students get a taster of university life and an insight into a specific STEM subject. Students will get the opportunity to experience university style lectures and work on activities and group projects with the support of academics and student mentors. Students will stay in halls of residence and will take part in social activities in the evenings.

These courses are for Year 12/S5-6 students and are a great way to try out a STEM subject at university before applying. This allows students to make a better informed decision for their UCAS application, as well as meeting like-minded students from all over the UK.

These summer schools are run for small groups (on average 30 students) and so places are limited.





Applications for the 2023/24 A2B scheme are open until 15 February 2024. Completing the programme will bring you a range of benefits including an alternative offer and funding. We encourage you to explore our programme information and eligibility and consider applying.



Get talking!

No one knows a university better than its students. so take the opportunity to talk to them during campus tours and accommodation visits.

Plan your day

Decide in advance which talks you want to go to so you don't miss the topics you're interested in.

Make notes

There's a lot to take in so it'll help when you come to comparing different universities and colleges afterwards.

Ask questions (lots of them!)

Make a list of what you want to know before you set off and check you've got all the answers before heading home.

Keep in touch



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
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
