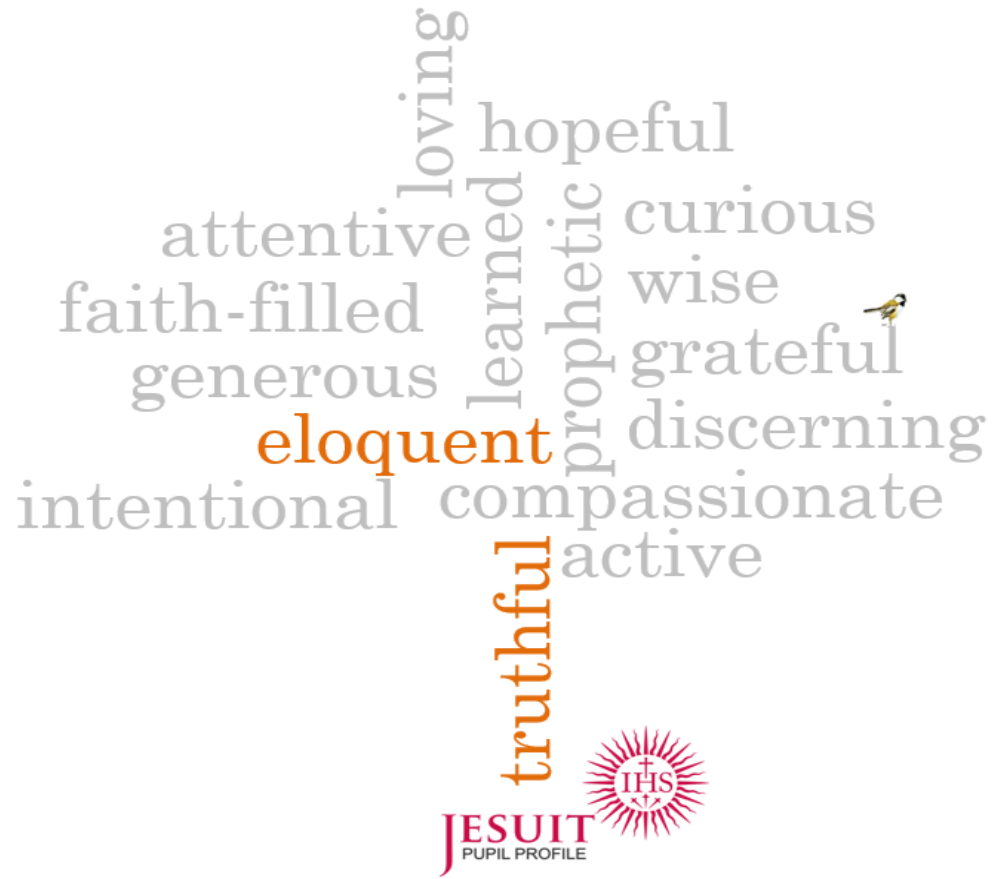

# WHAT DO THIS TERM'S VIRTUES MEAN?

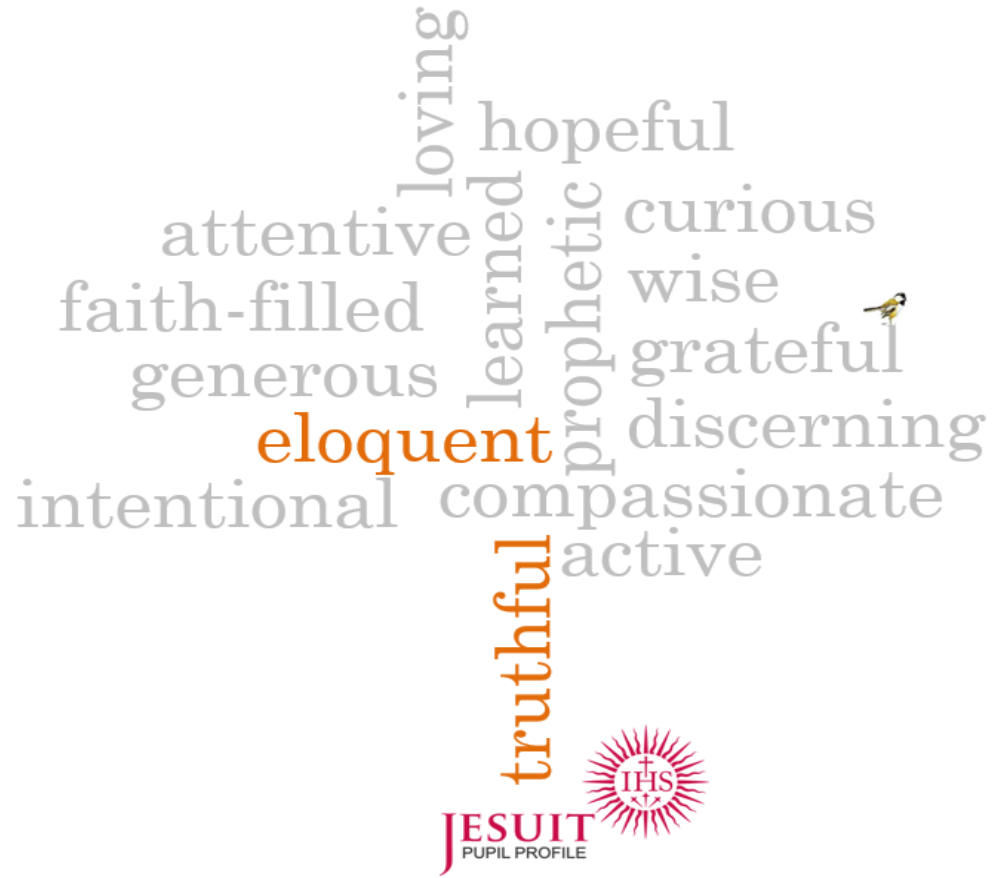


## ELOQUENCE MEANS.....
