#### What community outreach have you been doing?

#### **Reception Parent and Carer Support Sessions**

Throughout September and October our SCZ doctors, Fran Dutton and Haseena Iqbal, have visited 8 primary schools to deliver support sessions for parents

and carers of children starting reception this year. We know these children may have higher needs than previous year groups, due to the limited support available during the COVID-19 lockdowns, so we wanted to make sure we could equip parents

and carers with some key tips.

Lots of different topics were covered during these sessions, but a few examples of the advice given revolved around how to create good daily routines,



how to improve oral hygiene, toileting, and the importance of giving children nutritious foods. During these sessions we also gave each parent and carer a toothbrush and some toothpaste for every child at home under 16.

In these support sessions, we reached a total number of 107 families and we also managed to give out 263 toothbrushes!

#### **Well Child Checks in Schools**

On the 8th of October, Nurse Jo begun her Well Child Check's with one of our local primary schools. These checks aim to do a general health overview of the child, and target key problems, such as diet and weight management, and oral health.

We are really excited about doing these health checks in school, as they are a great way to gain a broader insight into the health inequalities of the area, and to reach those families who have not yet visited our clinics.

#### **New Clinic Opening!**

Through consultation with families, we discovered that there was a need for an evening Sparkbrook Children's Zone clinic for those who cannot attend the daytime clinics. Therefore, we have opened a new clinic at Fernley Medical Centre, on Thursday evenings, 4pm to 7pm. At the clinic there will be Doctor Abusibah, and our Sparkbrook Children's Zone Family Support Advisor, Nazmeen Rahimi.

We are excited to have a clinic located in the heart of Sparkhill, and we hope that the broader spread of clinic's throughout the area will help families have

more choice in attending a clinic which more easily accessible to them.



This month we have also trialled an evening clinic at Highgate Medical Centre on Wednesday evenings, as we know that some of our families are needing to travel further to reach clinic. We want to make sure we are making ourselves as accessible as possible, and eliminating as many barriers as we can for families to attend Sparkbrook Children's Zone.

#### **Healthier Together**

The Healthier Together website is designed for parents and carers of children and young people to use when they are unsure about their child's illness. On the website, you will be able to explain the symptoms of your child, and receive NHS approved advice about how to treat your child at home, or whether you should contact 111, or A&E.

We believe Healthier Together is a brilliant tool to share with parents and carers to help promote safe and healthy medical advice.



To get support for a child, young person, or a family, complete the Family Connect Form (FCF) and give as much detail as possible. This will enable us to understand the family needs and provide appropriate support from within the Early Help Partnership.

If you are a professional, please complete the <u>Family Connect Form - For</u> Professionals.

If you are a parent, carer, or young person, please complete the <u>Family</u> Connect Form - Self Referral.

Please also use the <u>Postcode Checker</u> to check which Early Help district your family falls under. You will need this when asked on the Family Connect Form.
