# **Dyslexia Fact Sheet**

#### Dyslexia is ...



A brain based issue that makes it hard to learn to read accurately and fluently.




A lifelong condition. Pupil's do not outgrow dyslexia, but with the right support, key skills can improve.



A common learning issue. Many successful people have it, and researchers have been studying it for over a century.

#### Dyslexia is not ...

- A problem of intelligence. Pupils with dyslexia are just as able as their peers.
- A problem of vision. The core issue involves understanding how the *sounds* in words are represented by letters.
- A problem of laziness. Pupils with dyslexia are already trying hard. They need more help to make progress.



## Ways to help pupils with Dyslexia

**Multisensory structured literacy instruction** engages pupils through sight, hearing, movement and touch.

**Accommodations** help pupils learn and show what they know, like doing an oral report instead of a written assignment.

**Assertive technology** tools, like audiobooks and text-to-speech apps, can help level the playing field for struggling readers.
