It is important that students wear the correct uniform every day to maintain the high standards we set and to promote a sense of equality amongst all students.

We would like to specifically bring your attention to the following points-

- Blazers must be worn
- Jumpers are optional but should not be worn instead of a blazer
- No jewellery apart from a single set of gold or silver stud earrings worn in the lobe of the ear must be worn- necklaces, bracelets, rings, and nose studs are not allowed.
- If your child currently wears footwear identical or similar to the styles shown below they will not be allowed from September 2025, students must wear practical school shoes not trainer type footwear.



When your child started at Bishop Challoner Catholic College, as part of the parenting contract you agreed to 'Ensure that my/our child wears full school uniform and has full PE kit'. We kindly ask that you continue to fulfil this responsibility each day. This contributes to a positive school ethos, supports our focus on learning, and helps students develop a sense of responsibility and pride in their appearance.
