- Funeral
 - a) Liturgy of the Word-Gospels on Resurrection
 - b) Liturgy of the Eucharist-receive the Host
- **Palliative care-** caring for the terminally ill; allowing pain alleviation.
- **Hospice** a place that gives palliative care like Acorns.
- **Extempore prayer-** a personal prayer to God; one we make up as we go.
- Catholics against Euthanasia: Sanctity of Life [Gen 1:26/ Jer 1:5]; ALL life has value
- *Evangelium Vitae* says Murder, Abortion, Euthanasia and Capital Punishment are ALL threats to life.
- 10. Salvifici Doloris to understand the saving power of suffering; joining in on the suffering of Christ, the redemption and salvation He brings and helping others to do the same.
- 11. Iconography on sarcophagi: Faith, Belief and History.
 - A) Empty Cross-Resurrection

 - b) wreath for victory over death c) Jesus' Passion- we all suffer; suffering ends

- **1. Relativism:** The belief that there is no moral law and that rules that govern what is right and wrong are human inventions and change from place to place and from age to age.
- **2. Paschal Mystery-** Everything Jesus does to offer us redemption and salvation as a part of God's plan for Salvation of Mankind.
- 3. St. Augustine says REHABILITATION is the best punishment. 'There is no space to reform character except in this life'
- **4. Redemption-** the action of being save from sin, evil or error.
- 4 Natures of the Catholic Church:
 One Holy Catholic Apostolic
- **Tabernacle:** Holds the Host (body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ). It is said to be the heart of the Church because the Eucharist is the SUMMIT of worship.
- **7. Evangelisation:** Literally means spreading the "good news" which we translate as Gospel. The sharing of the Gospel and life of Jesus with others.
- 8. 'The Church for salvation'?
 Pope Benedict says 'it is absolutely necessary'
 Pope Francis says 'God is the one who says who goes to heaven'
- Two exterior features of a Catholic church?
 - A) Cruciform- shape of a cross for redemption and salvation.
 - B) Steeple- raising our minds, to God- Our Father who art in Heaven
