- Students will sit a maximum two papers per subject

- Parents/Carers will be informed of mock examination results via email.
- The purpose of the mock examinations is to give an indication of progress made by students during Year 12.
- The mock examination results, and results from other class-based assessments throughout the year, will be used in discussions with students about future pathways and inform, but not determine, their UCAS predicted grades.


