Many of our Year 13 students go to local universities but a number also travel much further. In 2017-18 students went as far South as Exeter and Winchester and as North as Hull York Medical School.

A third of students who progressed on to university achieved places at Russell group universities.

The most popular university destinations in 2017-18 were Nottingham Trent (12), Birmingham City University (10) and University of Birmingham (6) and the most popular degree courses were Law (5), Geography (4) and Psychology (4).

The range of courses that students have gone on to study is impressive and include Classical Studies, Cybersecurity, Engineering Geology and Geotechnics, Fashion Branding and Promotion and Criminology, Policing and Investigation to name a few.

We were delighted that 4 out of the 7 apprenticeships secured by students in 2017-18 were degree apprenticeships. The most popular type of apprenticeship was Quantity Surveying.
