You will compare one of these with the unseen. The question will be set out like this. You will have the unseen poem and the post - 2000 poems printed in a Source Booklet. You will have a choice of two questions. Each will name a different post 2000 poem and a different theme or idea

Read the poem	of the source booklet and reread the anthology poem
Compare the methods both poets use to explore

You will need to revise the following poems:

- Twice
- Maude Clare
- An Apple -Gathering
- Remember
- At Home
- The World

#### **Consider the following themes:**

- Death
- The way women are portrayed
- Temptation

The question will name a poem and ask you to select a relevant poem to compare it with.

You will be given a blank booklet of the poems. You will need to revise context
