Your Year 13 Mock Exams will be taking place in January

You will sit **TWO** papers. Both will be **TWO** hours long. Both will be in the morning and you will sit them in the Auditorium
Paper 1 will take place on **Wednesday 13th January** and will be about Education and Research Methods and will be worth 80 marks

Paper 2 will take place on **Wednesday 20th January** and will be about Families and Households and Beliefs in Society and will be worth 80 marks

Paper 1 Topics

Q1 will be about ethnic differences in educational achievement 4 marks

Q2 will be about gender differences in subject choice 6 marks

Q3 will be about the effects of increased parental choice on pupils' experience of education 10 marks

Q4 will be about sociological explanations of the role of education in transmitting ideas and values 30 marks

Q5 is the MIC question and will be about using field experiments to investigate the effects of teacher labelling 20 marks

Q6 will be about using documents in sociological research 10 marks

Paper 2 Topics

Q1 will be about how changing gender roles may affect children's experience of childhood 10 marks

Q2 will be about the effect of migration patterns on household structures 10 marks

Q3 will be about functionalist explanations of the role of the family in society 20 marks

Q4 will be about how globalisation may affect religious beliefs and practices 10 marks

Q5 will be about how religion can lead to social change 10 marks

Q6 will be about whether science has a greater influence than religion on people's lives 20 marks
