What does each component look at? Head - (<i>decision making, knowledge, analysis, confidence</i>), Hands (<i>physical, technical, competition, fitness</i>), Heart (<i>social, emotional, effort, attitude</i>). Students would be expected to demonstrate evidence of these within their Year 9 PE Assessment window(s).</p> <p>Expectations. What should students already know? Students in Year 9 will demonstrate good subject knowledge of the Rules & Regulations for each Sport (Year 7 content); can practically demonstrate the Skills & Techniques needed to be successful in each Sport (Year 8 content); and will now look to demonstrate an awareness of the different Strategies & Tactics needed to strengthen their own/their teams performance within competitive situations (Year 9 content).</p> <p>Invasion Games – Football, Basketball, Handball, Netball, Tchoukball.
