No teacher will ever say...

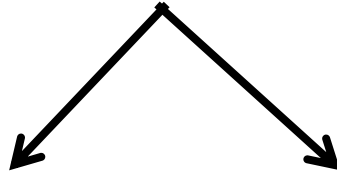
Children just have to put

What are the facts?

- 30% of people lie about their age on social media sites
- 1 in 8 young people don't know how to block someone on a social media site from speaking to them
- 65% of young people don't make their social media settings private
- 70% of young people share private information like their DOB, address, school etc., with people online

2. Sending and receiving inappropriate messages or images
3. Receiving horrible messages online or over text
4. Speaking to strangers online
