As we look forward to the publication of GCSE results please find details of the collection of results and the enrolment procedure for those students that have applied for a place at Bishop Challoner Sixth Form College.

All students have been allocated a time and a venue to collect results from and enrol (if required) with a member of staff. In order to help us manage the number of people at school at any one time, we ask that students do not arrive any earlier than their allocated time. Only students should attend, and parents/carers and students are reminded not to gather at the entrance to the school or enter site without a pre-arranged appointment.

Senior staff will be available on the day to answer any students' questions about grades. Miss McGowan the careers advisor will also be available.
