As the closure of school continues for the majority of students, communication between home and school is extremely important. Please see below some important information regarding online work for all students-

### Year 7, 8, 9

Please continue with all work set online, students can communicate with teachers via email if support is required.

#### Year 10 and Year 12

Regular communication will be expected between students and teachers and we would expect students to email their class teacher once a week.

Students will be expected to return the work that is requested from them by the given deadline.

Work completed via other platforms will be monitored. Expect contact from your class teacher if deadlines are not consistently met.

We will inform you of your son/daughter's school email address and they should be checking it regularly.

Work will now also be sent directly to students email addresses as well as on the school website.

Teachers will include their email address on all work that is set. Expect weekly reminders of the above.



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#### Year 11 and Year 13

Students should continue completing any work/tasks that are being set by their teachers. Students should also be making use of the 'Preparation for....' documents on the school website.

With effect from next week every student will also receive a telephone call from either a member of our Student Services or Support Staff Team. The purpose of the call is to simply check in and make sure the students are accessing the work that is being set.

Staff will be calling from either the school number or 'Withheld or No Caller ID' will be displayed if calling you on a mobile phone. Calls will be made every other week on average until the students return.
