The date that we will be taking part in this challenge is **Monday 22nd June.** To complete the challenge you will need some plain paper, a pen or a pencil and a willingness to try, as well as access to a device that can connect to an internet browser. No calculators, phones, maths books, textbooks or internet searches should be used.
