In light of recent developments please also be reminded of the following important information-

- School remains fully open for all year groups. Our whole school attendance last term was 94%, a fantastic achievement given the circumstances and one that has been acknowledged by the Local Authority.
- All students should attend school as normal at their designated staggered start time on time. Lateness to school means missed learning time, all students need to be in their classroom ready to learn by their start time.

Please note- from Monday 9th November **Year 9** students need to be onsite by 8.50am to start lessons at 8.55am, a change from the current 9am start.

- Year 7-11 students need to be in full school uniform or full PE kit including their blazer on days that they have a PE lesson. PE kit should be badged Bishop Challoner kit. Jogging pants and leggings will soon be available to purchase directly from school, all PE kit can be purchased from Clive Mark.
- There are sanitiser stations positioned around the school but we would expect students to also bring in their own individual supply. There will be sanitisier available to purchase in school along with masks, these costs will be deducted from your son/daughter's Schoolcomms account.
- As the weather is set to become colder and with the school needing to be well ventilated in line with Covid-19 guidance, students are encouraged to wear a school jumper under their blazer if necessary. Royal blue jumpers for Year 7-10 and Burgundy jumpers for Year 11 are available to purchase from Clive Mark. Hoodies or any other form of additional layer under a blazer are not allowed.
