University of Birmingham Open Day

As part of their compulsory careers programme, we are arranging for all Year 12 students to visit the University of Birmingham Open Day on Friday 28th June 2019.

This will be an occasion for students to experience at first-hand what university life is like. There will be opportunities for students to visit subject departments and talk to current university students and lecturers, as well as seeing student accommodation and some of the sports and leisure facilities.

Students will need to make their own way to the University of Birmingham campus. They should assemble in front of the Clock Tower in Chancellor's Court at 9:00am. Staff will be there to meet and register them. University of Birmingham campus is easily accessible by train and bus and a map will be issued to all students the week of the visit.

Students will have a number to call in case of an emergency, and staff will remain on campus, but they will not be directly supervised throughout the day, as they will wish to attend different talks or visit different facilities, according to their interests.

Students must register back at the clock tower at 12:00pm and will be dismissed from there. Students will have seen the open day programme in advance, so if they know they will be late to register back due to a clash with a session they want to attend, they must let Mrs Nutt know at the start of the day. The open day will be continuing until 4:00pm and students are welcome to stay to attend other sessions, after they have been dismissed and staff will remain on site until 2:30pm.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink with them, or money to buy lunch at the university. There is a wide range of catering facilities on the campus.

This is a visit that all Year 12 students are expected to take part in and we would be grateful if you would please give consent via SchoolComms.
