September 2019 - Important course information

Due to A Level reforms, all of our A Level Programmes of Study are now offered as two-year courses. This means that all students currently in Year 12, who enrolled on A Level courses in September 2018, are on two-year courses and it is our expectation that they will complete these courses in the summer of 2020.

Should a student wish to change A Level courses at the end of Year 12, they will be required to restart Year 12 in all subjects. As a result of our decision to no longer offer AS level qualifications (with the exception of Further Mathematics and Core Mathematics), it will no longer be possible for students to simultaneously follow Year 12 and Year 13 courses.

Work Experience

A number of students have already secured valuable work experience placements. However a significant number of students have not. Completing a quality work experience placement is not only an essential part of our careers MAKE THE GRADE

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education programme but it is also one of the requirements of students returning into Year 13. Students must complete either a two week placement, or, two different placements for one week. It is vital that students complete a Confirmation of Placement sheet and a medical form once they have secured their placement(s). Absence and Illness
