How can parents give the gift of reading and ensure their child reads for pleasure?

- Set the expectation of 10-20 minutes daily reading.
- Read with your child whenever you can (even those at secondary school).
- Limit screen time.
- Provide books or encourage the use of the school or community library.
- Show an interest in what your child is reading.
- Set an example by reading your own books.

'Reading for pleasure' is when a pupil chooses to read a written text such as a book or magazine, or listens to an audiobook, for enjoyment

Reading for pleasure is different to learning literacy, which our pupils do in the classroom with their English teachers.

Pupils should be encouraged to choose the books that they read, based upon a number of factors, including:

- Their own interests.
- The genre of the book.
- The length and difficulty of the book.
- The size of the font within the book.

Some books are designed especially for pupils with dylsexia and other learning difficulties. Other formats such as audiobooks allow for pupils with visual impairments to experience reading for pleasure. There are books available for everyone!
