The last few weeks at Bishop Rawstone have been hectic on a variety of levels. Year 11 have all been working through mock exams and staff are now marking them to get results back to them quickly. Year 10 went to the theatre to see Blood Brothers and the whole school has been involved in November Remembrance activities. On top of all that, we also had our Church Of England SIAMS visit. (Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools).

We can now report that this inspection could not have gone any better. Throughout the visit the inspector was effusive about all he saw. Speaking with staff, observing staff and students together, and speaking with students separately gave him a very positive picture of a thriving church school. The RE department was also very carefully scrutinised, and as the report shows, he was impressed by all he saw there too.

After a full 2-day visit, involving over 30 different sets of interviews, the overwhelming feeling was that the inspection team had visited a school committed to living out its core values and holding its vision at the centre of what it does.
