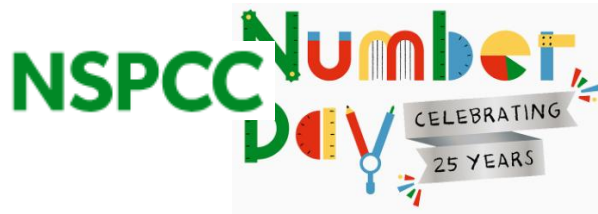

We are delighted to be supporting the NSPCC by taking part in Number Day on **Friday 6 February 2026**.

The NSPCC needs our support more than ever. By raising money, we can help to fund their vital services such as Childline – the helpline that’s always there for children and young people whatever their problem or concern.

Safe fundraising

We have set up on iPayimpact a donation of £3. Each donation will be entered into a virtual balloon race. Donation payments will close on Sunday 8 February and the balloons will set off on the following Monday. You can follow your balloon on the leader board and via a link which will be posted on the school website. The race concludes on Wednesday 11 February. Each balloon moves a random distance twice per hour over the 48 hours. The winning balloon, which travels the furthest, will earn a Maths goodie bag for its owner.
